- i) Val () is a function that changes the data given by the user in a text box to a number format.
- ii) The Button is the most commonly used control. It is used to start or stop a particular process. Sometimes, it can also be used to interrupt a process.
- iii) Microsoft Visual Basic is a very easy-to-use programming language. It is used to create window-based applications or software using the tools and controls provided with it.
