RABINDRANATH TAGORE

Rabindranath Tagore was born in the famous Tagore Family of Jorasanko in Kolkata on 7th May, 1861. His father was Maharshi Debendranath Tagore and mother was Sarada Devi. From his childhood, he began to write poems. He could also sing well. He wrote many poems, songs, short stories, novels and essays. In 1913, he won the Noble Prize in Literature for Gitanjali. For his writings poems of uncommon nature, he got the title "Viswakabi". Mahatma Gandhi regarded him as "gurudev". He established the Viswabharati University at Santiniketan in the district of Birbhum. He refused "Knighthood" in protest against the Jalianwalabagh Massacre in 1919. He has endless love for his country and countrymen. This great song of Bengal died on 7th August, 1941. But his thoughts and ideas will never die.
