## 7) PREPARATION OF HAND SANITIZER

Hand sanitizer is a liquid,gel or foam generally used to decrease infectious agents on the hands. It is prepared in a few easy steps at home. It is made up of four main ingredients —isopropyl alcohol(rubbing alcohol), aloe vera gel or glycerine, hydrogen peroxide and distilled water. At first, these ingredients are collected from different sources. Then, isopropyl alcohol and glycerine or aloe vera gel (3:1 ratio) are poured into a clean container. Then, they are mixed thoroughly with a teaspoon to ensure that the alcohol is evenly distributed throughout the gel or glycerine. After that, hydrogen peroxide and distilled water (1:1 ratio) are added to the solution and stirred well. Next, a few drops of essential oil (lemon or lavendar) is mixed with the solution for fragrance. Now, liquid hand sanitizer is ready for use. Finally, the solution is poured into a spray bottle for easy use.
